The Job: The Footwear Department Lead provides leadership as a key member of the retail team, supervising a team of staff to maximize sales opportunities, provide outstanding customer experiences and ensure that our Footwear Department standards are met consistently. This position reports to the Store Managers and will work closely with the other Department Leads and the entire retail team.

Key responsibilities:

- Directly responsible for in-store customer service and sales results, with a focus on the Footwear Department.
- Assist in the planning and organizing of day to day operations of the Footwear Department to maximize sales and productivity.
- Motivate and lead staff to maintain all standards relating to customer service, readiness for business, merchandising of product, store cleanliness, presentation, staff relations, and compliance with company policies.
- Assist in the preparation of weekly staff schedules to ensure cost-effective work assignment scheduling and increased team productivity by organizing resources, delegating responsibility, monitoring progress and ensuring accountability within the Footwear Department.
- Coordinate the team and follow up on execution of prep to sell activities, including sale pricing, floorplan changes, cleaning, inventory turns and organizing of stock rooms to ensure outcomes are achieved within the allotted timeline.
- Communicate with Buyers/Warehouse team on a frequent basis regarding sales cycles, product trends and inventory level.
- Propose and initiate plans/ideas to improve the client experience.
- TRAIN! Help build a talented team of sales associates/cashiers to enhance the effectiveness and efficiency of the overall team through the hiring process, orientation, coaching and evaluating performance on a consistent basis.
- Pro-actively improving your product knowledge and taking advantage of training opportunities.
- Operate as a front line manager/Department lead, promoting, monitoring and improving the quality of service provided by staff by training, acting as a positive role model (share your passion for the activities we support!), and quickly resolving any client concerns.
- Assumes Store management responsibilities in her/his absence; opens and closes the store when required.

- Collaborate with Store Management to implement customer referral process to the Sales Associates.

- ✓ Lead the product knowledge training/standards within your department.
- ✓ Proposing action plans/ideas to improve sales/customer service experience in your department.
