

Marty's Reliable Cycle

2021 Group Ride Guidelines

- Riders must read and sign this document and hand it to the ride leader prior to the beginning of the ride.
- Do not participate in the ride if you are feeling ill or have been exposed to someone feeling ill recently.
- When gathering at the meeting place maintain a 6ft. distance. Face coverings are strongly recommended.
- No more than 15 people will ride per group. If more than 15 people show up, the ride leader will divide everyone into smaller groups.
- There will be a minimum of 10 minutes between the start time for each group.
- Groups should not rejoin each other during the ride.
- Proper distancing of at least 6 ft should be maintained at the meeting place, rest stops, red lights, stop signs, etc. Wearing face mask at a rest stop is highly recommended.
- Helmets are required to join any of the group rides. If you do not have a helmet you will not be allowed to ride with the group
- A bike in good working condition is also required. If your brakes or other components are not functioning properly it can endanger the entire group.
- No spitting or expelling fluids from your nose or mouth. If you must please make sure you are at the back of the group and out of everyone else's way.
- All riders must carry a face covering.
- It is recommended that all riders bring their own personal hand sanitizer.
- A headlight and taillight are strongly recommended.
- Ride leaders have the right to ask any rider to leave the ride when guidelines are not followed.

You acknowledge that:

Bicycle riding is inherently dangerous and that riding in a group can increase your chances of contracting COVID-19.

You will take reasonable precautions to minimize the spread of COVID-19 and you will conduct yourself in accordance with the guidelines above as well as the recommendations of public health officials.

Marty's Reliable Cycle Waiver: In consideration of permission to participate in Marty's Reliable Cycle rides wherever they are located, I on behalf of myself, my heirs, personal representatives and assigns, do hereby release, discharge, and agree not to sue Marty's Reliable Cycle, it's employees, ride leaders, and agents from and for any and all claims arising from the ordinary negligence of a released party. This waiver and release applies to (1) personal injuries, sickness and death and (2) loss of, damage to or theft of personal property. This waiver and release shall be interpreted and controlled by New Jersey law and any lawsuit concerning this waiver and release, personal injuries or property damage shall be brought only in New Jersey.

You have read and understand all of the above and will abide by all of the terms and conditions of the ride waiver and the supplemental guidelines for group riding.
