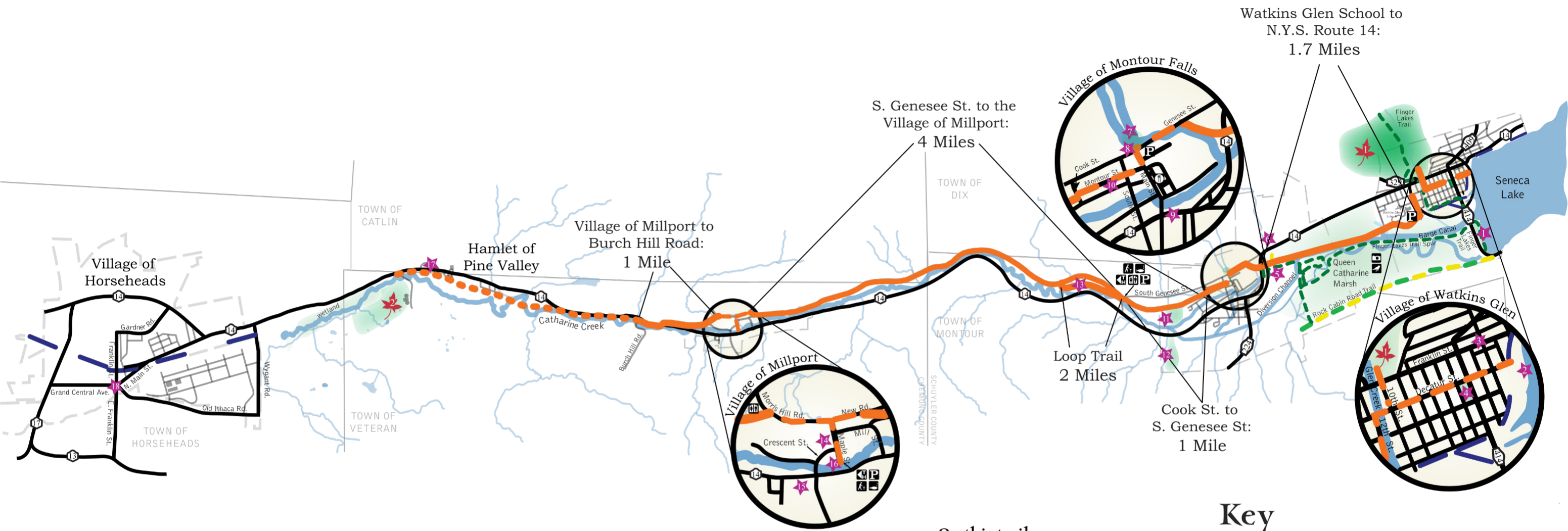


Catharine Valley Trail

Please respect the rights and privacy of our neighbors...

- Motorized vehicles are not permitted on trail.
- Dogs must be kept on leashes no longer than six feet at all times. Please clean up after your dog.
- Horses are not permitted on trail.
- Hunting is not permitted on trail.

Rules of the Trail...

- Stay to the right except when passing.
- Bicyclists must yield to pedestrians.
- Give a clear warning signal when passing by saying "on your left."
- Pass slower traffic on the left, yield to oncoming traffic when passing.
- Yield to other trail users when entering or crossing the trail.
- When stopped, move as far right as possible, and remain on designated trail.
- Do not remove anything natural from the trail.
- The trail is open from dawn to dusk.
- This facility is designated "Carry In-Carry Out." Please take your trash and recyclables home with you for proper disposal.
