INTENDED USE

45North's Cobrafist is a cold weather riding supplement to be used in addition to gloves or mittens. It keeps out the elements beyond what a glove or mitten can do alone. The Cobrafist is intended for flat or riser mountain bike handlebars only.

CAUTION! Installation of 45North's Cobrafists may affect bicycle handling and riding. Always ride with extra care and attention in wintery, rainy, and windy conditions.

GENERAL SAFETY CONSIDERATIONS

Riding bicycles in the winter is a lot of fun. You get to ride in different places, in different ways, with different gear than most other seasons. Our mission at 45North is to enhance the comfort and control our customers experience while riding in cold weather. While we produce gear that improves control on ice and snow, there are inherent risks one assumes while riding in such conditions. Like other cycling disciplines, winter cyclists have different skill levels and experience. It is your responsibility to ride in ways that do not jeopardize your safety. We help you gain comfort and control with technical solutions for hands, feet and traction. You help yourself by using your common sense! With that, here are some basic winter cycling guidelines to consider:

- Use blinking lights and reflective materials on your bicycle and body
- Dress in layers using clothing made of wool, synthetic fibers and windproof materials
- Carry spare gloves, socks and a light insulating jacket with real or synthetic down-fill
- Riding studded tires on ice or snow does not provide the same amount of traction as a normal tire on pavement—use caution whenever you ride on ice or snow!

TOOLS REQUIRED

3mm Allen wrench

INSTALLATION

- Remove any handlebar-end plugs before installing Cobrafist pogies.
- 2. The right and the left pogies should be oriented with the 45North logos facing skyward and upside down to you (figure 1).
- 3. Unzip the zipper on the neoprene extensions at the upper left of your right pogie, and the upper right of your left pogie.
- 4. Those open ends go over the grips, shifters and brake levers and are now pointed towards the stem of your bike (figure 2).
- 5. Open the foam inserts and place the circular end over your handlebar. The forward slot of the insert is for your cables (figure 3).
- 6. Once the insert has everything in place, slide the insert just inside the ends of the pogie, and zip the zipper down around it.
- 7. Line up the large rivet at the upper right of the right pogie and the upper left of the left pogie with the ends of your handlebar (figure 4).
- 8. Place the 45North bar-end plugs through the rivet and into your handle bar-end (figure 5).
- 9. Use a 3mm Allen wrench to tighten the bar-end plug snug enough to hold the Cobrafist in place.
- 10. Adjust the zipper of the vent below the 45North logo depending on temperature and riding conditions (figure 6).
- 11. Get outside, and laugh in the face of cold, wind, and snow.

CARE & MAINTENANCE

Machine wash cold and drip dry when needed.
