

## Centreville Central 18.9 miles



The county seat and geographic center, this ride includes some nice forested sections, and a little more vertical relief than you'll find on Kent Island. Convenient to several restaurants, the tradeoff is a little more traffic, so take note of the cautions on the route description.



## **Directions:**

- 1. Route runs clockwise starting at the Route 18 Park.
- 2. Turn RIGHT on MD Route 18 (4-H Park Rd). (0.5/0.5)
- 3. Turn RIGHT on Wrights Neck Rd. (1.5/2.0)
- 4. Turn RIGHT on Spider Web Rd. (1.3/3.3)
- 5. Spider Web Rd becomes MD Route 304 (Corsica Neck Rd). Continue STRAIGHT. (0.6/3.9)
- 6. Turn RIGHT on Dulin Clark Rd. (1.1/5.0)
- 7. Turn LEFT on Brownsville Rd. (0.9/5.9)
- 8. Turn RIGHT on Hibernia Rd. (1.4/7.3)
- 9. Turn LEFT on MD Route 18 (4-H Park Rd). (0.4/7.7)
- 10. Turn RIGHT on MD Route 213 (Centreville Rd). (2.9/10.6)

  BE ALERT OF HEAVY TRAFFIC!
- 11. Turn RIGHT on John Brown Rd to US Route 301. (2.5/13.1)
- 12. CAREFULLY CROSS US ROUTE 301 and continue on John Brown Rd. (0.9/14.0)
- 13. Turn LEFT on MD Route 18 (4-H Park Rd). (\*) (1.0/15.0)
- 14. Turn RIGHT on Joseph Boyles Rd. (2.0/17.0)
- 15. Turn RIGHT on Tilghman Neck Rd. (1.0/18.0)
- 16. Turn LEFT on MD Route 18 (4-H Park Rd) back to the start. (0.9/18.9)

## Shortcut:

(\*) For a short loop, turn RIGHT on MD Route 18 (4-H Park Rd) back to the Route 18 Park totaling 9.1 mi.
